The New Zealand National Boccia Championships is seen as the most important Boccia tournament of the year. It is one of three sanctioned tournaments held each year in which players can compete and earn national ranking points.

Competition dates

Start: Thursday 26th October, 2023 (8:30am – 6.00pm approx.)

Finish: Sunday 29th October, 2023 (8:30am – 4:00pm approx.)

Classification

Please note all athletes require at least a provisional classification to compete. This involves completing a Medical Diagnostic Form prior to the competition which is assessed by a classification panel. Please note the Medical Diagnostic Form does include a part which must be completed by a medical doctor.
